Chaplain

The Mission of the PTSD Foundation of America is to bring hope and healing to Combat Veterans suffering from the effects of combat-related Post Traumatic Stress. The Chaplain will be an integral position to ensure the overall spiritual wellness of the foundation for staff and individuals who chose to utilize our services.

Job Description: The Chaplain will work closely with the President, Director of Clinical Services, and the PTSD Foundation of America's (PTSDFOA) mainline staff to effectively communicate the organizations mission. This individual is responsible for developing and delivering the spiritual care and training that upholds the company's brand and support the company's spiritual functional areas to achieve their overall organizational objectives

Key Accountabilities:

- Create content for all development-related spiritual pieces including Program evaluation and improvements at Camp Hope, curriculum development for Community based outreach groups.
- Mentoring of PTSDFOA staff members in spiritual matters congruent with the organizations mission and values.
- Assist with the creation and implementation of a spiritual development plan.
- Provides leadership in performing and creating necessary ministries as required.
- Serve as lead staff member on matters concerning the faith section of the foundation.
- Orients, trains and helps provide on-going education and support for employees, residents and families.
- Provides spiritual assessment and pastoral care to residents, families and staff.
- The chaplain seeks excellence in pastoral care, which requires authentic demeanor, compassion and skill in dealing with the spiritual dynamics of illness, loss and death.
- Knowledge, adherence, and implementation of the rules and regulations of the PTSD
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- Knowledge, adherence, and implementation of the rules and regulations of the PTSD Foundation of America.
- Work closely with supporters of the PTSD Foundation of America to ensure the mission of the organization is conveyed effectively.
- Maintain a grateful, professional demeanor always with team members, staff, volunteers and community partners.
- Train lay leaders who conduct religious education programs.
- Advise leaders at all levels regarding morale, ethics and spiritual well-being.
- Oversee religious education programs.
- Other duties and special projects as assigned.

Position Requirements:

- Bachelor's degree from a four-year accredited university or college; advanced degree preferred.
- Minimum of 6 years' experience in pastoral or chaplain setting.
- Strong interpersonal skills and the ability to create and maintain solid working relationships at all levels across the organization and externally.
- Strong oral communication skills to make persuasive presentations to individuals and groups.
- Ability to maintain confidential and/or proprietary information.
- Proficiency in the use of Microsoft Office software applications required.
- Qualified candidates must have Ordination or Commission to function in a ministry of pastoral/chaplain care and has received the endorsement of and is in good standing with his/her body of faith

Physical Requirements:

- Regularly requires sitting or standing for extended periods of time.
